### Election Workers Needed



Retired? Enjoy working in your community? Need Community Service Hours?  
**2018 Election Dates: Tuesday, August 7th and November 6th**

Election inspectors are people who are paid to assist voters at the polls on Election Day.



#### To be considered for an appointment as an election inspector:

-  An inspector must be a registered voters in the State of Michigan
-  Willing to declare a party to insure a balanced election
  -  Able to sit or stand for periods of time
  -  Able to lift or help lift items
  -  Able to understand and take directions
  -  Must attend a training class every two years
  -  Requires a high school diploma or equivalent
-  Ability to work cooperatively with fellow election works and the general public
-  May be a high school student (16 & older) *Does not have to be registered to vote*
  -  Desirable qualifications: Ability to use computers

Inspectors are paid hourly for training and Election Day  
Inspectors must report at 6:00 a.m. on Election Day and work long hours.  
Part Time may be available.

#### **A person is ineligible to serve as an election work if:**

-  Is a candidate or member of candidates immediate family
-  Is a felon or convicted of election crime

\* A "known active advocate" of another political party is defined to mean a person who 1) is a delegate to the convention or an officer of another party; 2) is affiliated with another party through an elected or appointed government position or; 3) has made documented public statements specifically supporting by name another political party or its candidates in the same calendar year as the election at which the person will serve as an inspector. "Documented public statements" means statements reported by the news media or written statements with a clear and unambiguous attribution to the applicant.
